## APPLICATIONS AND PAYMENT

To secure a sponsorship, complete the acceptance form and return it to SA MET Unit via [HealthSAMET@sa.gov.au](mailto:HealthSAMET@sa.gov.au).

Sponsorship packages where there are limited opportunities will be allocated to those organisations in order of acceptance forms received.

On receipt of the enclosed sponsorship form, confirmation will be sent via email with a tax invoice for the total amount if the requested sponsorship level is still available.

As sponsorship levels are limited, returning an acceptance form does not guarantee a place at the requested level. The SA MET Unit will advise if your requested sponsorship level is no longer available at the time of application.

If your payment is not received by the invoice due date the sponsorship will be released to other interested organisations. In this instance, SA MET Unit will contact you to advise your requested sponsorship has been released.

## BRANDING AND EVENT DELIVERY REQUIREMENTS

## DEADLINES

The deadline for the delivery or supply of materials, information or artwork are not negotiable. If materials, information, or artwork are not received by the due date, use for their intended purpose cannot be guaranteed. The value of these entitlements will not be refunded if this is the case.

## TRAVEL AND ACCOMMODATION
