2024 Review

- Aligned with: Updated Australian Medical Council (AMC) Guidelines
- Survey reduced: From 42 to 27 questions
- Removal of repetitive items.
- More concise wording for clarity and completion ease.

Accessibility

- Each LHN will have a single user account on Survey Monkey, created from the SA MET Unit's primary account.
- Survey Monkey access is funded by SA MET. There is no cost incurred by the LHN.
- The single user account on Survey Monkey will enable the MEU to view, edit, send and evaluate data responses.

Benefits

- Standardised data supports accreditation assessments of terms and LHNs.
- Can be used during accreditation visits, reducing need for additional surveys.
- Allows inclusion of site-specific questions for local insights.
- Minimises survey burden on prevocational doctors.
- Enables timely evaluation, improvement, and recognition of training programs.
- The wording has been carefully crafted to ensure the data collected from junior doctors provides the SA MET Health Advisory Council and Accreditation Committee with the information they need to make informed decisions.
- Each LHN will have a LHN specific master template.
