Amendments to Accredited PGY1 & PGY2 Terms in Clinical Learning Australia (CLA)

Purpose

A process for amending accredited Postgraduate Year 1 (PGY1) and Postgraduate Year 2 (PGY2) terms in Clinical Learning Australia (CLA).

Overview

CLA is an ePortfolio that records the development, training and assessment of PGY1 & PGY2 doctors across all states and territories in Australia. CLA has been developed to provide a consistent approach to prevocational training and assessment in line with the Australian Medical Council (AMC) National Framework for Prevocational Medical Training and governed by the National ePortfolio Board. 
Any additional amendments (i.e. Archiving of accredited terms) in CLA must also follow the process outlined in this document.

Monitoring of Terms in CLA

The SA MET Advisory Council, through the SA MET Accreditation Committee will monitor accredited PGY1 & PGY2 terms in CLA through Local Health Network (LHN) Prevocational Training Accreditation Cycles.

Process

The process for amendments to accredited PGY1 & PGY2 terms in CLA is outlined below.



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
